ORDER TO COMPLY: As a result of an inspection of these premises, violations of NFPA 1 Fire Code and/or NFPA 101 Life Safety Code have been identified for correction. **Life Safety violation(s)** not corrected **before the re-inspection date listed by the violations**, will result in additional follow up inspection established by The Fire Prevention Bureau of Anchorage Middletown Fire & EMS.

If the violation(s) still has not been corrected after the follow up inspection, the business owner / property owner may be subject to fee(s) pursuant to KRS 227.336. It is the responsibility of the business owner, manager or designated representative to correct all noted violations.

According to KRS 227.336 If the Anchorage Middletown Fire & EMS Fire Prevention Bureau is required to make additional inspections, beyond the initial inspection and a second follow-up inspection, to determine if the required corrections have been made, we shall assess a fee against the property owner to recover the cost of each additional inspection according to the following schedule:

Third inspection fee.....	\$100.00
Fourth inspection fee.....	\$200.00
Fifth and subsequent inspection fee.....	\$500.00

Failure to immediately correct Imminent Life Safety violations that are deemed Dangerous to Life Safety may result in a Fire Watch being imposed at the owners' expense and/or closing of the business until violation corrections are made.

Note: Records of inspection reports are maintained by the Fire Prevention Bureau of the Anchorage Middletown Fire & EMS and are part of public record requirements of the State of Kentucky. It is possible that information contained in these reports in addition to your failure to correct any noted fire code violations may be used against you in civil and/or criminal proceedings in the event of an incident related to any such violation.

Re-inspections may or may not be performed on the date listed below. The date of the re-inspection below is simply the date on which corrections are due. If violation is corrected prior to the reinspection date, please feel free to email the inspector.
